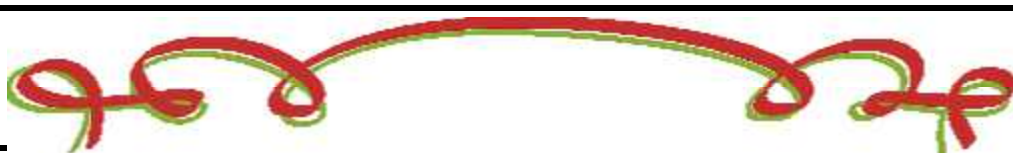

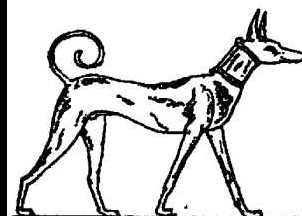

President's Message

It was a wonderful national in Tennessee. In addition to fun activities and seeing old friends, we had a productive board meeting and a lively annual membership meeting where great ideas and suggestions were expressed. I've included a synopsis below for those of you who were not able to attend.

As you know, Kacey got scared during the conformation event and ran away. After a lot of work from a lot of people, we all breathed a sigh of relief when she was returned home. You'll see an article on this later in this issue.

Board meeting

The Corresponding Secretary, Rita Sacks reported that 46 breed brochures and breeders' lists were sent out in 2008, each accompanied by a copy of the PHCA Code of Ethics. She feels that the people who contact her are much more educated about the breed these days because of our website.

The AKC Delegate, Gary Reed, reported that AKC is now accepting registrations from imports direct from Malta. He also reported that AKC is concerned that they are seeing continual diminished registrations and are now competing with several other registries in the US. This is a very serious issue and could impact their ability to sponsor events in the future. Realizing that the only thing PHCA could do to help was to encourage breeders to make sure all their puppies are registered with AKC, the following motion was presented and approved:

PHCA requires Pharaoh Hound breeders to complete AKC registration, along with permanent identification (microchipping), prior to puppies leaving the breeder's home in order to be listed on the PHCA approved breeder's list.

The Health Committee Chair, Stephen Sipperly, reported at the meeting that the Health Committee has created a web survey that several board members have tested. Once the board has approved the suggested changes, the survey will be sent out to member.

The Education Committee Chair, Rita Sacks, reported on educational activities throughout the year. There was discussion of materials used at some events that were not sanctioned by the committee or the board and included information we felt did not reflect the pharaoh hound temperament or its history. The following motion was presented and approved:

Any handouts at PHCA sponsored events must use existing approved materials or have approval from the education committee chairman.

Preferred Breeder's List

It was agreed that this list be called the approved breeder's list instead of preferred, which is a more accurate description of the list.

The problems with the list are: a.) a person sends in microchip data on a single litter but then remains on the list for years to come, b.) there are people on standing committees who are breeders but are not on the breeder's list. Therefore the following motions were presented and approved:

Any member in violation of the COE is not eligible to be a member of a PHCA committee.

Add to the requirements to be on the approved breeder's list: an individual must renew annually and have puppies permanently identified to fulfill approved breeder requirements.

The board will develop a written application for the approved breeder's list and publish in the Scribe annually for breeders to update their status.

There was also discussion on the club's nonprofit status of 501(c)7. The IRS is targeting clubs and insisting that they move to a 501(c)4 status. Cynthia will follow up on this to see if it relates to PHCA.

Membership meeting

Many of the issues identified above at the board were discussed at the membership meeting. In addition, there were several ideas presented at the membership meeting:

- Add board minutes to the PHCA members' website.
- Publish when PHCA sponsored seminars are held in the Scribe.
- Results of treasury audits published in the Scribe.
- Improve our contact and development of Juniors.
- Create a DVD or CD with picture pedigrees, "words of wisdom" from long-time breeders.
- Create a booth display for events such as Meet the Breeds that could be shipped to locations.
- Create an online pharaoh hound pedigree program on the members' website.

The board will take up these suggestions at our meetings next year.

If anyone has ideas, questions, concerns or suggestions for our club I would love to hear them. We're a volunteer organization. Your ideas and energy are what makes this club successful. Please don't hesitate to email me at crguinn@comcast.net.

Have a fun and safe year with your dogs and we'll see you at the 2009 National in the Northwest in September.

General Membership Meeting Minutes (continued)

President's Message:

Cynthia reviewed the dates of upcoming PHCA .

Eastern Specialty will be held on June 27, 2009, in MA

Western Specialty will be at Lompoc, CA one more year on July 24, 2009

National will be held on September 4, 2009, in Eugene, OR.

We are open to proposals for the 2010 National.

Laurie Laventhall moved that we approve the minutes from the 2007 meeting as published in The Scribe, Bonnie Folz seconded and motion was unanimously approved.

Recording Secretary Report (Sheila Hoffman)

New Members approved since the last annual meeting in April 2007:

13 individual memberships

1 Junior membership

1 Household membership

The PHCA now has a total of 140 members consisting of 75 individual memberships, 32 household memberships, 2 junior membership and 3 member clubs.

Corresponding Secretary Report (Rita Sacks)

Since April 2007, in reply to inquiries, 46 breed brochures and breeders' lists were sent out, each accompanied by a copy of the PHCA Code of Ethics. Many of the people with whom Rita spoke were very pleased that the COE was being included in the "packet" since they realized that the Code is actually a guideline for them when purchasing a Pharaoh Hound.

As usual, there are still those people who feel that dogs should be allowed to run free, but most seem to understand that this is not the way to keep a dog, particularly a Pharaoh Hound. There seems to be a better understanding of the breed by those who inquire. Rita believes that the PHCA website is instrumental in the positive education of the public regarding Pharaohs.

Some people think they can crate a puppy, or a grown dog, for 6-9 hours a day. If they cannot be convinced otherwise, it is suggested that they are not in the right situation to have a dog of any breed.

There were requests from only two judges for copies of the Illustrated Guide, which is disappointing.

Arrangements have been made for the PHCA to have a booth at the AKC-Eukanuba National Championship Dog show in Long Beach, CA, December 13 and 14, 2008. Robert Newman will be in charge of the booth.

A letter from AKC states that effective 1/1/2009 all event secretaries who administer nine or more AKC agility trials per year are required to be licensed the AKC.

Treasury Report (Jane Hodnett)

Total club assets at the end of September were \$30,902.35 of which \$9,876.14 is earmarked for rescue.

Quarterly financial statements will continue to be published in The Scribe.

AKC Delegate Report (Gary Reed)

The AKC has recognized FCI registrations which means imports direct from Malta can now be registered with the AKC.

A major topic of interest with the AKC is the diminished registrations with the AKC, downward trends and competing registries. This is a very serious issue impacting the future of the AKC that all need to be aware of.

There was a request from the floor that summarized meeting results prudent to Pharaoh Hounds be published in The Scribe. Gary agreed and will provide these as issues arise.

Rescue (Pam Haig)

Pam received a young female from upstate NY/Canada area during the National weekend. Probably from the unregistered litter that occurred in that region – this would make the 3rd or 4th puppy from that litter to come through rescue. She has already been placed with a home that had a Pharaoh Hound previously.

Health (Stephen Sipperly)

Stephen discussed the upcoming web survey that is close to board approval. It will be an electronic survey with the assistance of OFA.

Two more Pharaoh Hounds have qualified for CHIC numbers:

Nefer-Temu Flying Amaretto

XO's High Voltage at Lorilane

Education (Rita Sacks)

Since the last report there were PHCA judge's seminars in Washington presented by Cynthia Guinn, in Georgia by Pam Haig and in Maryland by Sheila Hoffman. A Hound seminar had been planned for September in Michigan but it was cancelled due to lack of interest. They will try again next year.

Any handouts or materials used at PHCA sponsored events must be existing approved materials or have approval from the education committee chairman.

Awards (Sheila Hoffman)

This year: 13 Dual Titlists, 5 Versatility Awards, 3 Versatility Excellent Awards, 3 ROM dams and 1 ROM sire

After some discussion at the board meeting, foreign titles shall not count for the individual dog awards of DT, VC or VCX as we are a US based club. Foreign titles can be included for ROM qualifications since offspring can be exported and not have the opportunity for AKC or US titles. Foreign titles which are like the most similar title on the current list will contribute to the ROM.

Ways & Means(Sheila Hoffman)

We have Mouse pads, Tiles, Mugs, Pins, Magnets, Water Bottles and Crate tags available for sale this year. Be sure to buy some today or at the banquet.

PHCA Website (Carmen Davis)

The website is getting over 2,000 hits a month. Most are hitting the Living with Pharaohs, Rescue and Frequently Asked Questions sections.

New Business Discussion:

Website survey input was discussed specifically with regard to the approved breeder's list not being listed on the public section of the website. It was explained that after discussing with some of the long term breeders, they would prefer this not be listed so callers would continue to be screened by the education chairman. It was agreed that we do need to make the contact for an approved breeder's list clearer on the website.

It was also requested that the board minutes be available to the membership. A quick show of hands indicated that of the members present, it was preferred that these be listed on the "members only" section of the website. The board will review this.

There has been a need for more volunteers and also members who have volunteered to help on a committee. To go out to the entire membership, we will publish the current committees and their function and request those interested in assisting a committee contact the committee chairmen.

Ads in The Scribe can be sent page ready or send the text and a photo and the editor will put together your ad. Deadline for The Scribe is the 10th of the preceding month, for example February 10 for the March issue.

It was requested that when there is PHCA sponsored seminar which is open to the public, that it be published in The Scribe.

It was suggested that the rescue committee review the cost currently in our policy for adopting a Pharaoh. The current \$75.00 is very low.

It was mentioned that treasury audits need to be published in The Scribe.

Another topic discussed was how to improve our contact and development of Juniors. It was suggested that we reach out to them and be sure they have a breed mentor.

Several members are looking for ways to access the founding breeders. It was suggested that members contact founding breeders directly and not be shy about inquires to them. It was the general feeling among those present that they are approachable if just asked. Some members suggested working on a DVD or CD with picture pedigrees, "words of wisdom" from those breeding Pharaoh Hounds for many years, etc. Dominic Carota volunteered to assist with a DVD/CD. It was suggested that we investigate pawvillage.com and SKIP website as these are existing online pedigree sites.

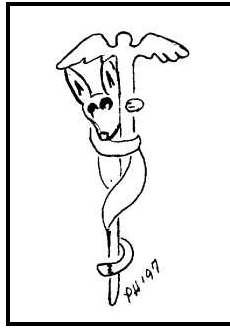
It was mentioned that the PHCA consider putting together a booth display for events such as Meet The Breeds that could be shipped to necessary locations.

Health Survey

Dear Membership

The *ELECTRONIC* Health Survey is now ready for access! There is an introduction page when the survey is opened explaining what to do. Each single pass through the survey is for only ONE dog in your household. You will have to go back and enter each dog in YOUR household that is currently living with you or that is deceased in the past year. This type of data gathering will provide more accurate information for the breed. It will take some time for those folks with multiple dog households to get your information entered in the beginning, so just take your time. The survey itself is very easy to do.

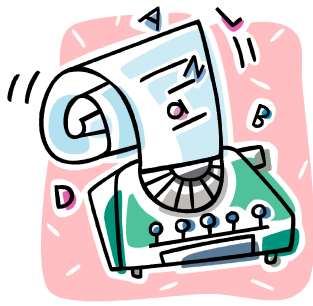
For those members who do not have computer access please contact me by phone or mail and I will send you our paper version to complete. It will be a version similar to the old survey.

Taking the health survey is a PHCA requirement to maintaining good standing with the club. At the end of the survey you will be asked to enter your name. This last page is NOT linked to the survey you just completed so the information cannot be linked. The last page is to record which members are taking the survey only. OFA is tabulating all data. Please be assured that this is highly confidential.

Obedient Pharaoh Hound

I decided, yet again, (Lord knows why) to see if Peanut would possibly pay attention to me in the obedience ring on Saturday, at the Town & Country Dog Training Club trial in Staten Island.

The last two times we attempted this were outdoor shows and there is no way I could keep her attention on me instead of her nose in the grass cleanin' up all the bait, or at least searching for it (I guess I really should get into tracking with her). But I figured, it's been quite a while, she seemed to do okay at class each week (the only time I ever get to work her). It's an indoor show (no grass to lose her nose in). George Molloy is judging Novice 'A' (a fellow Pharaoh Hound owner). It's only a half hour from the house (major plus), and it's the club's 50th anniversary show (I could at least go and support the club).

Well, after getting lost in some industrial park, we arrived with only five dogs left before our turn in the ring. There's no place to warm up, other than outside in the rain, if Peanut will not work for me when it's dry, I could forget about warm-ups in the rain. I left my training treats in the car anyway.

We're up. The steward calls us into the ring. The judge asked if we are ready for the Heel on Leash exercise, I'm thinking, 'no way, I must be out of my mind', but said "ready".

Forward, left turn, slow, normal (no tight leash) right turn (Peanut's still with me) halt. Forward, about turn, left turn, fast, normal, about turn, halt. We made it through!!

Figure Eight exercise am I ready? Yeah, what the heck. Peanut only trips me up some of the time trying to get around those posts. Would you believe, not a problem?!!

With the Figure Eight finished, the steward says "I'll take your leash" (fine with me, not nervous yet). Peanut never has trouble with her Stand for Exam, this is one of the exercises I was totally confident with and she aced it!

Next I hear "set up for the Off Leash Heel". Here's one of our biggest problems. Peanut being Miss Independent, once she knows she's off leash, it becomes wandering time cause you know there's always something better to do than follow Mom around the ring AGAIN. We just did this didn't we??

Did I mention that this facility is a skating rink, in a park that is one of these open air buildings where it has a full roof but the walls only go up about six foot high then there's another couple of open feet before the roof starts? As we are making our way to the starting point, a bird flies into the building and perches itself up in the rafters. Now if this had been Glory, I would have just marked a big NQ myself on our score sheet for the judge. I swear Glory thinks she's an Irish Setter, Labrador, or one of those bird dogs. Luckily Peanut doesn't give birds a second look.

I'm feeling myself get more nervous as we get set up. Peanut sits nicely for me but I know it's a 50/50 chance that when the judges says 'forward', I'll be walking the heeling pattern all by myself. If Peanut does decide to start off heeling with me, I usually lose her on the first turn.

So many things are running through my head when the judge asks "are you ready?" I softly stroke the side of Peanut's face, smile at her and say "ready". Forward, left turn, slow, normal, right turn, halt, forward, about turn, left turn, fast, normal, halt. All the while Peanut was right with me!!! OMG!!! I'm jumping for joy (on the inside).

Next is the Recall exercise. Confidence regained. We've practiced this in our yard for the past two weeks. Peanut would come when called every time, so long as there's no squirrels to bark at and even then she'll come once in a while. Of course there is always a treat waiting for her when she gets to me. The only problem, we used to have, was how mindful she is of body posture. If I even followed her coming in to me moving my head, just dropping my chin, she'd sit six feet away. We've worked on this quite a bit and she seemed not to worry so much about it anymore. However, I do have to stand straight as a board, smile on my face, and just follow her in with my eyes.

I call Peanut to 'come' and she did one of her best recalls with a nice square sit in front! Peanut favors the hand signal for the finish and got right into heel position with another nice sit!!

We leave the ring jumping for joy (on the inside) but not too cocky, the long sit and down exercises are always interesting.

If Peanut did nothing else, I would have been happy we got that far.

One of my students is ringside and tells me Peanut looked like a velcro dog and did so well we may have a high score! I don't think Peanut ever heeled off leash better.

We are called into the ring for our Long Sits and Downs. Peanut sits in place. While waiting to be told to 'sit the dogs', I stroke her ears and the side of her face. We are told to leave our dogs, and do so. Peanut likes to lay down during this boring exercise. My training partner told me not to let her lay down outside the ring unless I tell her to. She did try to lay down a few times, while we were waiting to go in, and I corrected her each time placing her back into a sit and then allowed her to lay down only after I told her to.

"Sit and Stay" I tell her next.

I'm looking at Peanut from across the ring, with a plastic smile on my face, hoping she sees past my worried, nervous look, and knows how pleased I am that she is doing what she's told, when she decides to look around. CRAP! This is where I'm gonna lose her! When the heck is the judge gonna say 'return to your dogs'? It feels more like five minutes instead of one.

Uh-oh, she's starting to look droopy!! Thankfully the judge says "return to your dog". I wanted to run back to her before I lost her but stayed in step with the other handlers. "Exercise finished".

What was the reason I entered her in obedience?? Sweat off a few pounds? Maybe get those grey hairs going?

While those around us roused their dogs with lots of praise and pets, I continued to stroke Peanut's ears and side of her face, quietly telling her what a good girl she is.

"Down and leave your dog" is what I hear next.

Now Peanut is fairly reliable on the long downs. We work with lots of distractions at class. Food is still high on her list of good reasons to break, however, there are no squirrels to distract her down at class.

Once again I'm standing opposite my beautiful girl, with the same plastic smile on my face. Peanut never lays down, off on one hip with a paw bent under like a good obedient dog does. She must be in the Anubis statue ready-to-run-at-the-first-moving-object-I-see stance.

There goes another bird. This time, it flies out of the building. Peanut follows it out with her head and with that, notices there are trees out there! And of course she knows, if there are trees, there are squirrels!! Peanut immediately straightened up, ears forward, head turned completely to the left, and I think to myself, this is not happening! I glance over at the judge, wondering if the battery in his watch died cause you know this is the loooonnnnggggeeesstttt three minutes of your life! I'm trying desperately to use mental telepathy to get Peanut to look and focus on me (I now know, animal communicator I'm not) and I'm thinking to myself, it's like bowling. Ya know when you throw the ball down the lane, and you know you have thrown it towards the gutter, and there's nothing at all you can do but you wave your hands and bend your body in the direction you want the ball to go in? Stupid, right?

Finally, the judge says "return to your dogs". Peanut immediately turns her head forward and watches me come to her. "Exercise finished". The best two words in the human language!!

As we are putting the leashes back on our dogs, the judge is calling out the numbers of the dogs with qualifying scores. We are one of them!!! We qualified!!! Our first leg of our Companion Dog title!!! I'm am gonna have an obedience dog!!! And it's gonna be a Pharaoh Hound!!! How cool is that??!!

All qualifying dogs are called back into the ring. The first place dog is a Clumber Spaniel, with a score of

one-ninety-something. I didn't really pay any attention cause I was so excited to be standing there as one of the qualifiers. Next, the judge says, "Second place, with a score of one-ninety-one-and-a-half, number 19". That's us!!!!!! Second place!!! OMG-OMG-OMG!!!! Beaming with pride and so excited, I was almost in tears. The Lord does know why I've entered her in obedience again!

Outside the ring, one of the club's members came over to congratulate us. She said she fell in love with a Pharaoh Hound at the Westminster dog show, and is on a waiting list for a puppy. When she told one of her fellow club members she'd be getting a Pharaoh Hound, the person asked her 'why would she ever get one of those? They don't do obedience!' After seeing Peanut in the ring, she was elated to go back up to her fellow member to tell them, Obedience COULD BE DONE with a Pharaoh Hound!

I'm so very proud of my Peanut.

Households with dogs should NOT contain sugarless gum!

Quick facts:

Two Deadly Effects of Xylitol

Hypoglycemia

In the canine body, the pancreas confuses xylitol with real sugar and releases insulin to store the "sugar." The problem is that xylitol does not offer the extra Calories of sugar and the rush of insulin only serves to remove the real sugar from the circulation. Blood sugar levels plummet resulting in weakness, disorientation, tremors, and potentially seizures.

It does not take many sticks of gum to poison a dog, especially a small dog (see full article for toxic doses). Symptoms typically begin within 30 minutes and can last for more than 12 hours. Vomiting and diarrhea may also occur.

Hepatic Necrosis

The other reaction associated with xylitol in the canine body is actual destruction of liver tissue. How this happens remains unknown but the doses of xylitol required to produce this effect are much higher than the hypoglycemic doses described above. Signs take longer to show up (typically 8-12 hours, but may take up to 48 hours) and surprisingly not all dogs that experience hepatic necrosis, will have experienced hypoglycemia first. A lucky dog experiences only temporary illness but alternatively, a complete and acute liver failure can result with death following. Internal hemorrhage and inability of blood to clot is commonly involved.

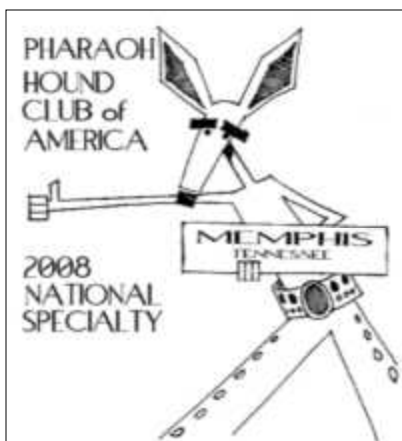

Pharaoh Hound Club of America Specialty
October 11, 2008
Judging Notes by Monica Canestrini

The Pharaoh Hound National Specialty, held with the Tupelo Kennel Club Saturday show in Memphis, TN, was a marvelous showcase for an ancient breed of dog and I was delighted to be part of the annual celebration for 2008.

When the Pharaoh Hound came into AKC some 25 years ago, hound exhibitors like myself were captivated by its grace and beauty, large mobile ears and amber eyes, the distinctive coloring and rosy blush when excited or happy. Needless-to-say but I was *very* happy to receive this welcome judging invitation.

The National drew a wonderful entry of 65 Pharaohs and I began judging with the breed template I always hope to find: a medium-size coursing hound with clean hard lines, slightly longer than tall, well-balanced, well-conditioned, alert and eager for the day's hunt. I especially wanted to see the dog in action with a free-flowing gait, head fairly high and tail curved, easily covering the ground.

In Class Dogs, it struck me that size and type continue to be much more uniform than in decades past; whippet-style and big coarse dogs have all but disappeared. Along with good consistency, I found good quality and temperaments. Only a couple of youngsters were hesitant, most entries in both sexes seemed confident and happy. Quality ran deep in the Bitches, boding well for future generations; whereas a few dogs had dominated in males, there were many deserving girls vying for the class ribbons and points.

The bar was raised high when 25 *competitive* Pharaoh Hounds, including impressive Winners Dog and Bitch littermates, joined battle for top honors. My 1st cut depended on dogs showing great attributes to best advantage; those dogs with a splendid structure and totally balanced stride, plus readiness for the hunt, went on. Side-gait became paramount until the ultimate picture of grace, power and stamina was achieved. Best of Breed was earned by a mature handsome fellow with awesome type and an easy fluid gait, the Best of Opposite Sex girl was beautiful, and, although I needed more 'Awards of Merit', just three were allowed on the day to further reward excellence in this noble breed.

"Thank you" to the breeders and exhibitors who brought out all those lovely dogs on Oct. 11. Thanks also to the hard-working National Specialty Committee for a 1st class event with gorgeous prizes (rosettes, medallions, crystal trophies) and friendly ambience. The post-show banquet featured an informative health program during the delicious meal, an incredible raffle, and 'Elvis'! My gratitude to everyone for such a memorable time.

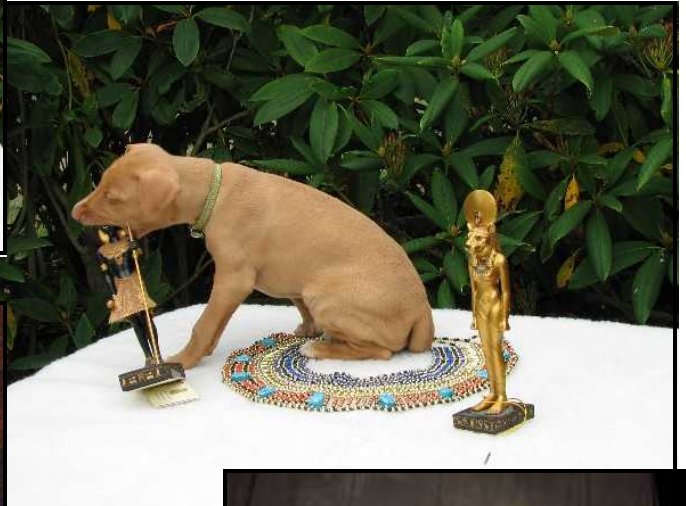
