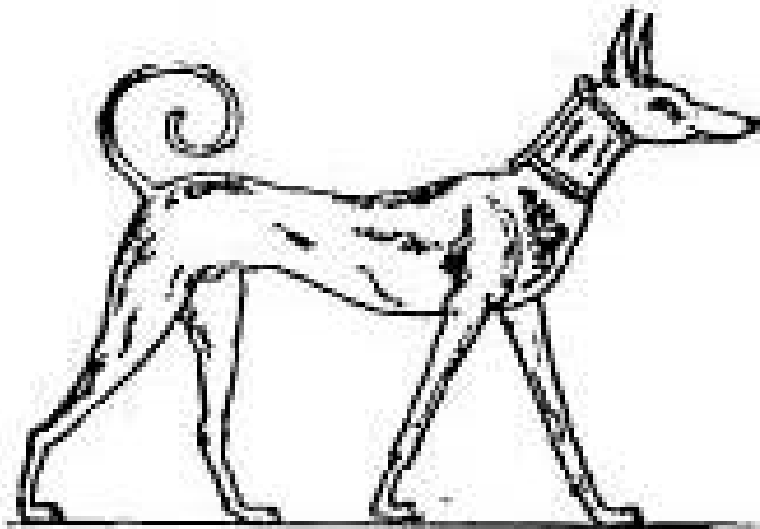

## PHARAOH HOUND SWEEPSTAKES

Judge: Mr. Brian Duggan

This Sweepstakes is open to all Pharaoh Hound who, on the day of the show, will be six months and under eighteen months of age, and entered in any of the regular classes at the show in which these Sweepstakes are held. Professional handlers may only show dogs in any sweepstakes class that are owned or co-owned by them.

### SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Divided by sex: 6 and under 9, 9 and under 12, 12 and under 18 months

After completion of the individual class judging, each of the class winners shall be brought back to the ring for the awarding of Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes.

Best in Sweepstakes- Exercise Pen, Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes- Solar Canopy

First in each class- Kong Wubba Friends, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> in each class- Bottle Caddy

## PHARAOH HOUND VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Judge: Mr. Brian Duggan

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to any Pharaoh Hound, 7 years of age & older. The dog need not be entered in any other class at the show. AKC Champions of Record and spayed or neutered Pharaoh Hounds are eligible. Professional handlers may only show dogs in any sweepstakes class that are owned or co-owned by them.

### VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Divided by sex: 7 and under 10 years; 10 and under 12 years; 12 years and older

After completion of the individual class judging, each of the class winners shall be brought back to the ring for the awarding of Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes.

Best in Sweepstakes- Orthopedic Dog Bed, Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes- Solar Canopy, First in each class- Kong Wubba Friends, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> in each class- Shammy

## PRIZE MONEY

The division of prize money will be as follows. Money will be rounded to nearest dollar amount.

To the host club to cover expenses - 35%. First place winner in each class 25%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 20%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 15%, 4<sup>th</sup> 5%.

## TROPHIES

### Pharaoh Hound Club of America National Challenge Trophies

**Best of Breed-** THE KHAN CHALLENGE TROPHY, a Bronze Reclining Pharaoh Hound mounted on a wooden base in memory of PHCA CH Twinley King Sesostris offered by Thom and Pam Haig, Mia Pharaohs. For permanent possession it must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. The trophy will remain in the custody of the donor until retired. The winner's name shall be inscribed on the trophy.

**Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed-** The family and friends of Marshall C. Durr offer a Bronze Sculpture of a Trotting Pharaoh Hound on a wooden base by artist Gary Newton in memory of Marshall Durr, owner, breeder, and handler of K'Azar Pharaoh Hounds. The name of the winning dog and owner(s) will be engraved on the trophy. A framed color photograph of the trophy with an engraved tag showing the winning dog's name and year of award will be awarded to the winner, along with an Egyptian Motif photo album. For permanent possession it must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows and will remain in the custody of the donors until retired.

**Best of Winners-** THE SAM SACKS MEMORIAL CHALLENGE TROPHY, a holographic image of a Pharaoh Hound Head Study embedded in crystal and mounted on a wooden base offered by Thom and Pam Haig in loving memory of Sam Sacks, a founding member of the Pharaoh Hound Club of America. The name and winning dog and owner(s) will be engraved on the base. A smaller version of the trophy (without the base) will be awarded to the winner. For permanent possession it must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows and will remain in the custody of the donors until retired.

**The “Jan Ault Breeder Owner Handler Challenge Trophy”-** This challenge trophy is offered in honor of Jan Ault, of NeKabu Pharaoh Hounds, who was the first ever Breeder-Owner-Handler to be awarded an All-Breed Best in Show win with her Pharaoh Hound “Simbel” BIS BISS Ch TiaRa NeKabu Abu Simbel Ankh.

The “Jan Ault Breeder Owner Handler Challenge Trophy” will be awarded yearly at the Pharaoh Hound Club of America’s National Specialty Show to the top Breeder Owner Handled Pharaoh Hound dog or bitch of the show in the Best of Breed class in the following order: Best of Breed Best of Opposite, Best of Winners, Winners Dog or Winners Bitch. The dog or bitch must have been bred and owner handled by the same handler for all classes entered at the PHCA National (excluding Sweeps).

The “Jan Ault Owner Handler Challenge Trophy” must be won three times by the same breeder owner handler but not necessarily with the same dog before it can be retired. The breeder owner handler retiring the trophy agrees to either sponsor a new trophy or re-donate the existing trophy back.

A similar trophy will be provided to commemorate the Breeder Owner Handler’s win.

This trophy is sponsored by Diane Conyers and Bonnie Folz.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

Coursing Dog and Bitch – Classes are for Pharaohs who are AKC registered and are confirmed Field Champions or Coursers of Merit. Exhibitors must supply proof of eligibility for this class with the entry. (A copy of the certificate awarding the title or a copy of the ENTIRE PAGE from either the AKC Gazette or FAN Magazine publishing the title will be accepted as proof.) Dogs/Bitches will not be entered in this class without proof of title accompanying the entry form.

First Place in the Dog & Bitch Class may compete in Best of Breed Competition

Veteran Dogs - For dogs 7 years of age and older

Veteran Bitches - For bitches 7 years of age and older

Best of Breed Competition - "The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC."

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

\*Stud Dog Class For Stud Dogs with two of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

\*Brood Bitch Class Same as Stud Dog Class, except replace "Stud Dog" with "Brood Bitch" and "Get" with "Produce". \*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

AWARDS OF MERIT The National Specialty often has a number of quality Pharaohs in competition exceeding the number of top awards available. After Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, and Best of Winners have been awarded, the judge at his/her discretion may award all or none of the Awards of Merit offered. (The number of Awards of Merit offered is determined by the total number of Pharaoh Hounds entered in the Best of Breed class, with one Award of Merit available for each seven Pharaohs entered in Best of Breed.) An Award of Merit acknowledges those Pharaohs who were considered, indicating the judge's recognition of an exceptional specimen of the breed.

BEST PUPPY CLASSIFICATIONS The Best Puppy competition will be for winners of the Puppy Dog and Puppy Bitch 69 and 912 regular classes only. Dogs over 12 months of age are not considered puppies. Judging will take place after the Best of Breed competition and after the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes.

## **GROOMING TENTS**

LMKC will provide grooming tents to be used at no cost to the exhibitors on a first come basis. No roping off of space under the tents will be allowed except for clubs with supported entries. NO exercise pens will be permitted underneath the tents. Generators permitted only in club assigned areas.

### **SELF CLEANING EVENTS**

These are self-cleaning show including hair. Failure to comply with cleaning up after yourself and your dogs may result in action by the Bench Show Committee.

## **TRAVEL DIRECTIONS**

**FROM THE EAST:** Take the Pomona Freeway (60) west. Exit at Euclid (83) and go south approximately 8 miles. The park entrance is on your left.

**FROM THE NORTH OR WEST:** Take Interstate 60 or 10 to the 71 Expressway and go south to Euclid (83). Turn left onto Euclid and proceed approximately 2 miles. The park entrance will be on your right.

**FROM ORANGE COUNTY:** Take the Riverside Freeway (91) east. Go north on the 71 Expressway. Exit right on Euclid (83) and proceed approximately 2 miles. The park entrance will be on your right.

**FROM THE SOUTH:** Take Interstate 15 to the Riverside Freeway (91) west. Go north on the 71 Expressway. Exit right on Euclid (83) and proceed approximately 2 miles. The park entrance will be on your right.

#### ADDITIONAL RULES

1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw, 5434 East Olympic Boulevard, Los Angeles CA, 90022, by Noon, Wednesday April 8, 2015 PT. Fees must accompany entries. This club and/or its superintendent assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendents assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check or declined credit card MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' Identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW.
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 6:30 am to 6:30 pm.
5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of judging of the breed. The superintendent's office will be advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available online at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org)
7. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
8. No grooming tables, pens, generators or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
9. No cell phones are permitted to be used in the rings for other than time keeping by Judge or Steward.
10. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
11. There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.
12. Declination of Entries. The Lake Mathews Kennel Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
13. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
14. Do not leave dogs in closed vehicles. The club will break into a vehicle if a dog is in danger.
15. A Recording Fee of 50 cents per dog, an Event Services Fee of \$3.00 per entry, and a Rally Fee of \$3.00 per entry at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)
15. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
16. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
17. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
18. Parents and/or Guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.
19. No flexi-leads on dogs allowed within the designated show area.
20. No moving of vehicles on grass or other parking within 100 feet of any show rings during any judging.
21. Bitches in season are ineligible to compete in trials. To receive a refund, a veterinarian's letter needs to be received by the Superintendent no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for bitch in season cancellations.

## OVERNIGHT PARKING

Overnight parking is by reservation only. The charge is **\$45.00 per night** per vehicle. Spaces will be numbered. All units must be self-contained. There will be no dumping of gray/waste water on grounds. The grounds are grass and dirt – come prepared with ground cover. To park with another vehicle, reservations must be received with fees in the same envelope and so designated. We will attempt to honor these requests. We ask that your parking space be left clean when you leave. Generators are not allowed on after 10:00 pm.

Handicapped parking spaces will be identified and available to those with proper DMV plates on a first come basis. Handicapped parking spaces will be identified adjacent to the unloading zone and parking area. Additional handicapped spaces will be available in the day of show parking. Those desiring handicapped parking should plan accordingly.

- **Proof of insurance** is required for all vehicles in any overnight parking area and must be shown at the park entrance.
- Parking reservation tickets must be presented at the park entrance.
- Overnight parking will be available Thursday and Friday beginning at 2:00 pm and closing at 10:00 pm. No exceptions. Parking will re-open at 6:30 am on Saturday and is available until 8:30 am. Overnight parking will re-open after Best in Show.
- Any abusive language or arguing with anyone on our show grounds will result in forfeiting of parking privileges and parking fees and may result in a bench show hearing.
- Failure to clean your area before leaving will result in forfeiting of future parking privileges and may result in a bench show hearing.

**Unreserved overnight** parking is on a space available basis for the fee of \$55.00
